

OUR PASSION

Our passion is to help unlock potential in financially challenged communities with resources for children and families, by educating and empowering them to give their best efforts in all they do to achieve in becoming the “best of the batch” in life.

OUR BLUEPRINT

To create communities where all kids and families are equipped with the tools they need to build their own best futures.

We provide a variety of different programs to serve every child who walks through our doors during their out of school time. Our STEAM program allows children the opportunity to engage in creative thinking in ways that utilize their strengths- whether that be through coding, 3D printing, robotics, or music production. Girl Talk engages both middle school and high school girls in a mentoring program where young girls receive accurate information and advice to navigate the challenges of growing up. Homework help and individualized tutoring are offered to every child who attends, which has resulted in an increase in school attendance and homework submission in participants. Grub Time is our out-of-school time meal program, where all children receive a hot meal including a protein, vegetable, fruit, starch, and a healthy snack every day. Functioning as the only completely free clubhouse within a two-bus transfer of our community, the out of school time programming Best of the Batch offers reflects the wants and needs of the surrounding community.

Our Foundation also provides outreach services through multiple programs, including our back to school readiness program BatchPacks, our holiday toy drive Batch A Toys, emergency response programming like our Comfort in a Basket initiative, and EITC, OSTC, Pre-K, and college scholarships.

INSTRUCTIONS

9 BALL POOL

STEP ONE:

Put balls 1 to 9 on the table.

STEP TWO:

Rack balls 1 to 8 in a diamond shape with the 1-ball in front.

STEP THREE:

Put the 9-ball in the middle of the diamond shape.

STEP FOUR:

Break.

STEP FIVE:

Shoot at the lowest number ball on the table.

STEP SIX:

Shoot at the next-highest number ball if you sink the first ball.

STEP SEVEN:

End your turn if you hit the ball but don't sink it, or if you miss the ball entirely.

STEP EIGHT:

Let your opponent take his/her turn by placing the cue ball anywhere on the table to line up a shot.

STEP NINE:

Continue shooting in turn until the 9-ball is sunk.

PING PONG

Celebrity Players Serve First! Be the first one to score 15 points to win. In the event of a tie, a player must win by two points.

WHAT YOU SHOULD KNOW:

On all shots, the ball must strike the end of the table before landing on your opponent's side of the table. If the sequence of shots is disrupted, a point will be awarded to the player not in error for any of the following reasons:

- The ball misses the table
 - The ball goes into the net without landing on the other side
 - The ball is not struck by the paddle
 - The ball bounces on your side twice
- Each player serves the ball five times, then the server switches. While serving, if the ball hits the net and continues on to the other side, it is called a "Let" and the point is replayed.

TEXAS HOLD'EM

STEP ONE:

The dealer deals each player their own two cards face-down (pocket cards).

STEP TWO:

First betting round.

STEP THREE:

The dealer burns a card then turns over three community cards face-up (the flop).

STEP FOUR:

2nd betting round.

STEP FIVE:

The dealer burns another card then turns over 1 more community card (the turn, 4th street).

STEP SIX:

3rd betting round.

STEP SEVEN:

The dealer burns another card then turns over 1 final community card (the river, 5th street).

STEP EIGHT:

Last betting round

STEP NINE:

Showdown (ever remaining player shows hand with the better showing first).

CORNHOLE

TOSSING:

- Players alternate throws until all 8 bags have been tossed (4 per player).
- You must toss from behind the front edge of the board (the "foul line").

SCORING:

- 1 point = Bag lands and stays on the board.
- 3 points = Bag goes through the hole.
- 0 points = Bag misses or bounces off the board.

CANCELLATION SCORING:

- Only one team scores per round.
- Subtract the lower score from the higher one.

- Example: Team A scores 7 points, Team B scores 4 points → Team A earns 3 points for the round.
- You must toss from behind the front edge of the board (the "foul line").

WINNING THE GAME:

- Keep playing rounds until a team reaches 11 points (or more).
- If both teams exceed 11 in the same round, the higher score wins.





The Educational Improvement Tax Credit (EITC) program allows Pennsylvania businesses to earn tax credits, which can reduce your tax bill dollar-for-dollar, for contributions made to an approved Scholarship Organization (SO), Educational Improvement Organization (EIO), and/or a Pre-Kindergarten Scholarship Organization (PKSO). Best of the Batch Foundation is an approved Scholarship Organization and Pre-Kindergarten Scholarship Organization.

WHAT IS THE OSTC PROGRAM?

The OSTC Program (previously known as the EITC 2.0 Program) provides Pennsylvania tax credits to qualifying businesses that make a donation to Best of the Batch Foundation. In essence, you are eligible to send Best of the Batch Foundation up to 90 percent of your tax bill, and claim the remainder as a charitable donation on your federal tax return. Best of the Batch Foundation uses these contributions to fund scholarships for students that currently live within the boundaries of low-achieving schools.




